- Uday Singh Further Developments in Monitoring the Blind Sub-Level Cave at Newcrest Mining's Ridgeway Gold Mine. More work has been done over the past year, mainly on using seismic data to track cave propagation.
- Warren Peck Ground Subsidence above Civil Tunnels due to Construction Dewatering. Even if no ground is lost into an underground excavation, the lowering of the watertable may be sufficient to damage buildings in a wide zone surrounding a civil engineering tunnel. A recent case history will be described.
